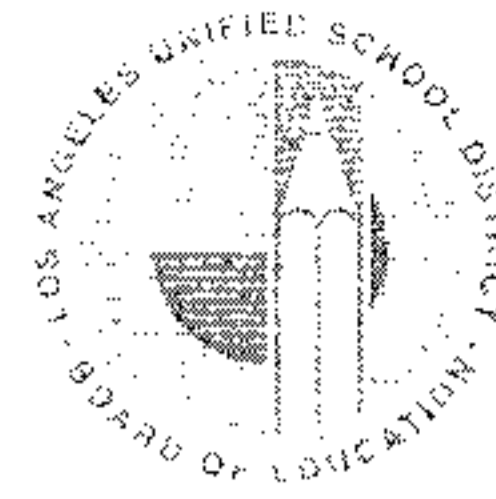




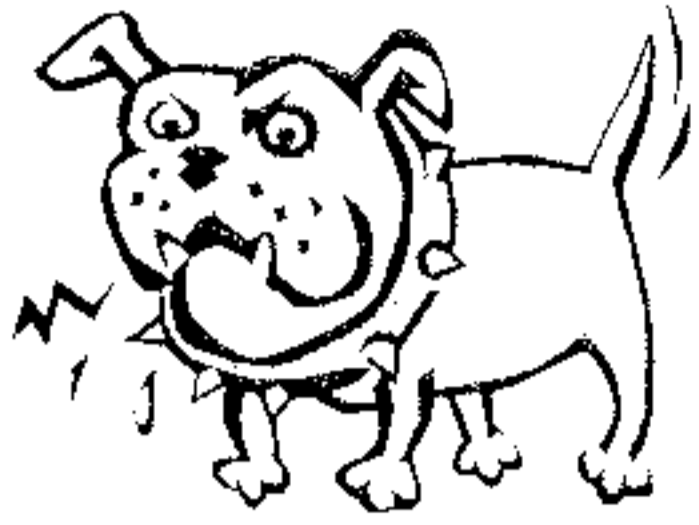

**ENTERING GRADE 9 - Fall 2009**

**Recommendations for a Successful Year at Jordan New Tech High School**

- Adult Family Member to attend a Family Information Meeting (student attendance is optional)
- Students spend a morning at Jordan New Technology High School (Freshman Bulldog Connect Days)
- Students submit a written reflection on their Freshman Bulldog Connect Day experience
- For PRIORITY registration, students submit a completed application the week before "Freshman - Bulldog-Connect days begin.

All of the above requirements and pertinent dates are addressed in the Admission Timeline will sent as soon as information is available. The required reflection essay must be at least two paragraphs, but, applicants may write more if they wish, but it is not necessary. Our 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Application is quite short and should not take more than a few minutes to complete. The letter of recommendation must be written by someone outside the applicant's family. Good sources for a letter of recommendation are a teacher, neighbor, clergy or other adult who knows the applicant well.

**ENTERING GRADES 10-12 - Fall 2009 (as a new JNTHS student 2009-2010)**

If you plan to apply for admission to Jordan New Technology High School for September 2009, as a new upper-classman you must do the following by the application deadline of 4:00 PM on June 26, 2009:

- Will have earned the following credits by June 30, 2009, in the following subjects:
  - 20 units (2 years) of English
  - 10 units or more of Algebra I, Geometry or Algebra II
  - 10 units (1 year) of World History
  - 10 units (1 year) of Science (Life preferred)
  - 10 units (1 year) of Physical Education (20 preferred - and needed to meet NVUSD grad requirements)
  - 5 units of Health
  - 5 units of Life Skills

- Have a parent and student (attendance by the student is required) attend one of the following mandatory Parent/Student Information Meetings where staff will share what students are expected to learn, how achievement will be measured, what courses and services the school will or will not provide the responsibilities of parents, and the requirements for enrollment in College courses
- Meeting and other important dates are issued on the day you return your enrollment packet or soon thee after...
- By the application deadline, submit a copy of the student's transcript, immunization record, and a completed student statement/application signed by the student and a parent/guardian.
