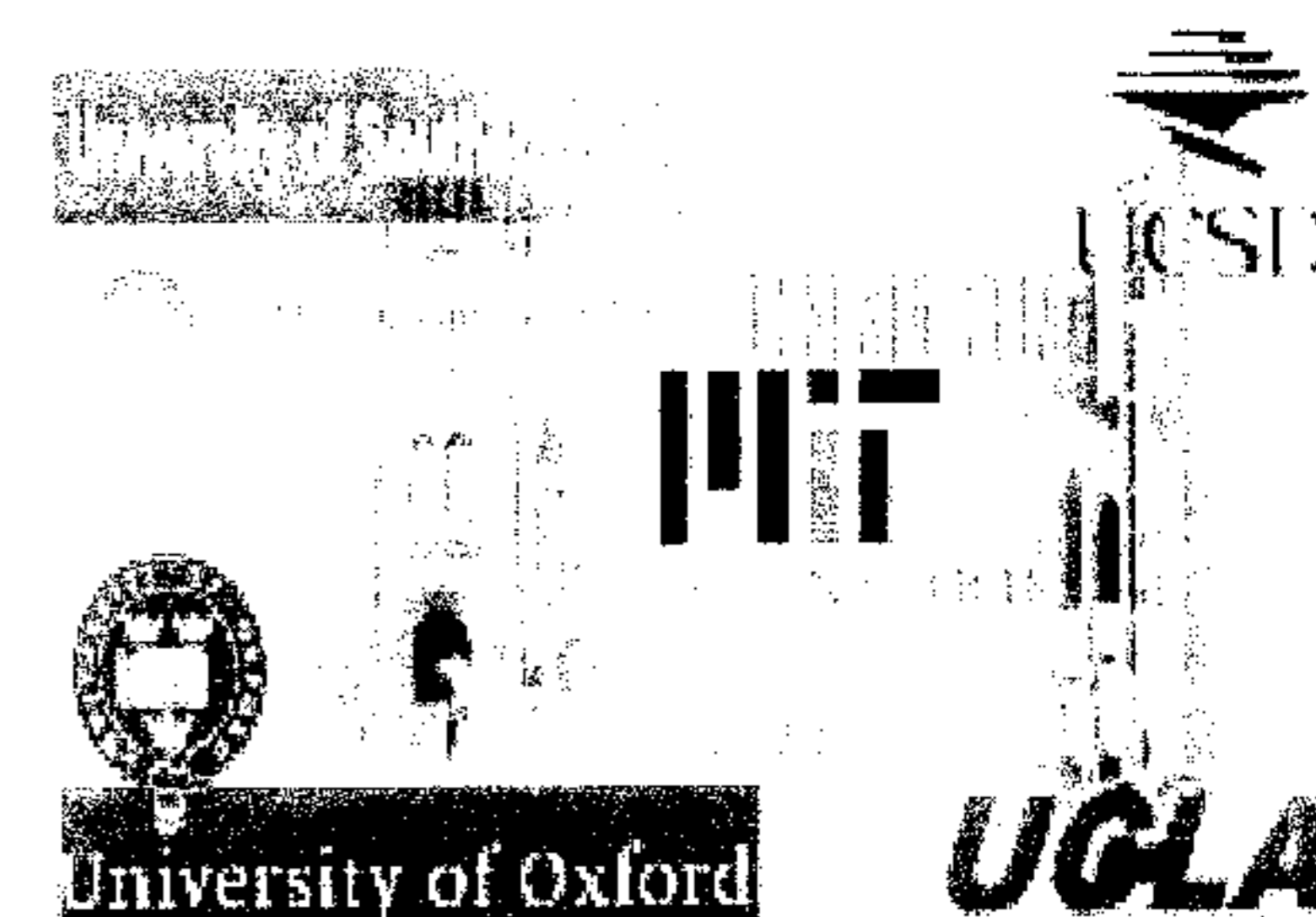

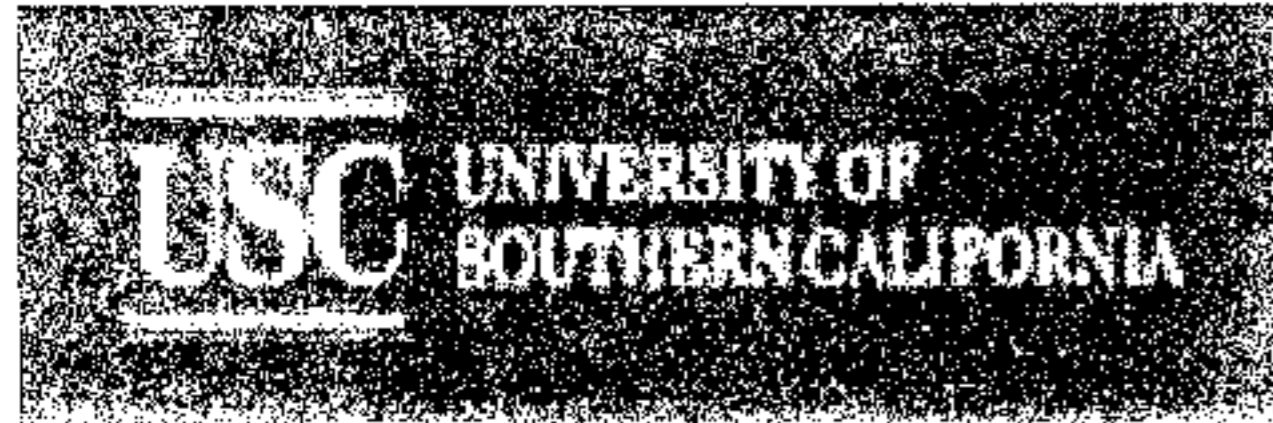

UPWARD BOUND

For students who like math, science, and engineering. It increases the number of students who graduate with degrees in math, science, and engineering with hands-on science programs and college and career counseling.

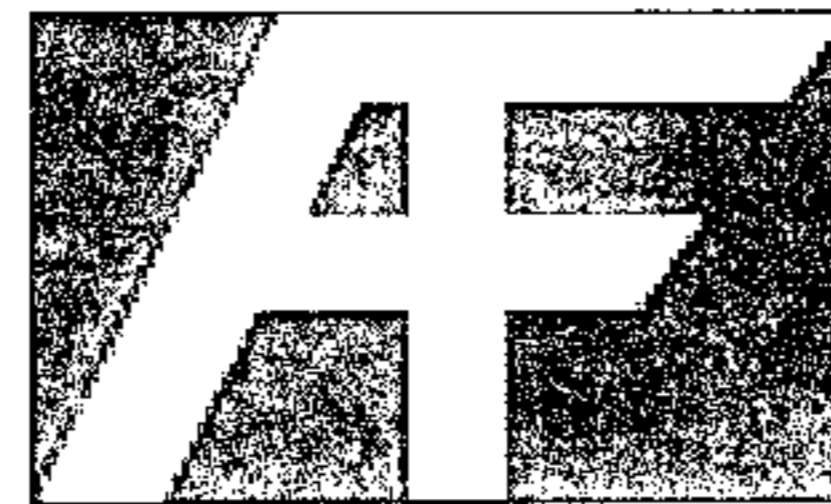


JAZZ REACH

The Academy of Finance teaches students

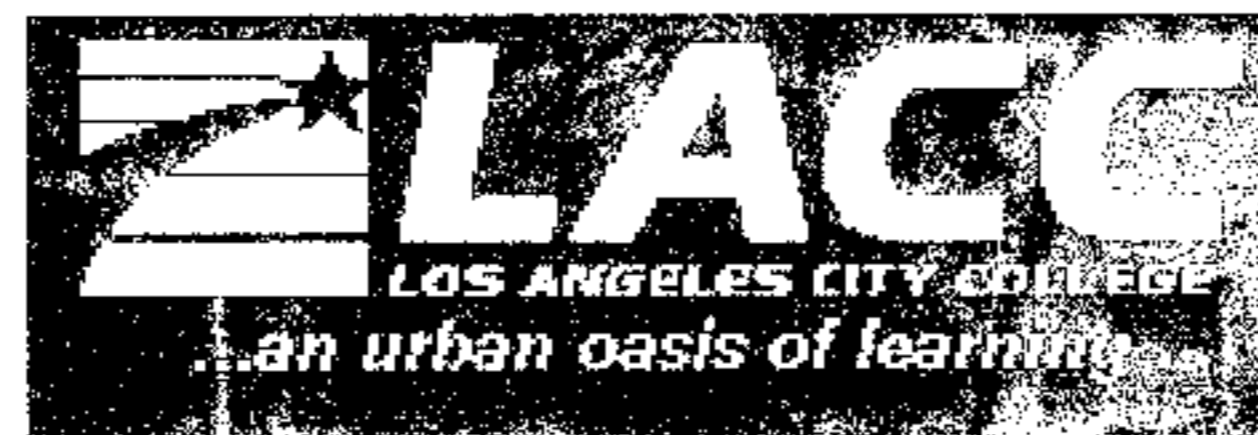


about economics, finance, and international relations.
