

## **APLE Teacher Incentive Loan**

APLE is a competitive teacher incentive program designed to encourage outstanding students to become California teachers in subject areas where a critical teacher shortage has been identified or in designated schools meeting specific criteria. Between \$11,000 and \$19,000 in outstanding educational loan balances can be paid by the California Student Aid Commission in return for four consecutive years of teaching service in one of the following teacher shortage areas.

- \* Mathematics (Grades 7 - 12)
- \* Science (Life/Physical) (Grades 7 - 12)
- \* Foreign Language
- \* Special Education
- \* Low-Income Area School
- \* School Serving Rural Area
- \* State Special School
- \* School with a High Percentage of Emergency Permit Teachers

Amounts above \$11,000 are associated with teaching of mathematics, science and special education in the highest need schools.
